1. Bumblebee



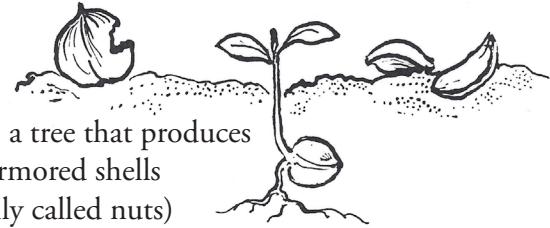
Cattails - a plant that can only grow in very wet areas



2. Downy Woodpecker



Hickory - a tree that produces seeds in armored shells (commonly called nuts)



3. American Robin



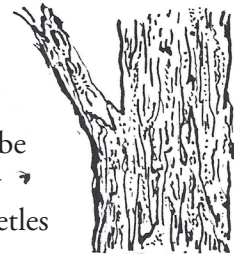
A tree whose saplings are often eaten by mice.



4. Gray Squirrel



A tree that can be preyed upon by various bark beetles



5. Bobcat



Lady's Slipper Orchid



6. Beaver



A tree that produces seeds surrounded by tasty, edible coverings (Such fruiting structures are often called berries.)
